Frequently Asked Questions

What are the key benefits of GemINTRO?

GemINTRO will empower participants to speak with confidence about gemstone essentials, including the most commercially relevant stones like diamonds, sapphires, emeralds, rubies and tanzanites, as well as birthstones. How long are course materials available?

Do I or my employees need a background in gemmology?

Does GemINTRO require any special equipment?

No. The only requirement is a stable internet connection and the ability to take notes for each chapter quiz. We recommend using Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox or Safari when accessing the site. Desktop computers, laptops, tablets and mobile phones can all be used to complete the course.

What is the process of logging in for a team?
